- 1) Question: Are we to assume that the remainder of the furnishings, including musical instruments, will be removed before construction begins?

Answer: Contractor shall remove all furnishings from the building to facilitate work per the contract. Provide two 10' x 20' climate controlled connex boxes for the storage of materials from inside BLDG 17. Contractor shall photograph, tag, record the location of, remove from the building, and store each piece of furniture. Contractor shall provide an electronic copy of the furniture condition pictures and furniture locations to the government on CD. Furniture includes but is not limited to: (1) piano, (1) organ, (1) podium, (1) altar, (1) sacristy with table, (1) candle prayer station, (8) chairs, (4) kneelers, (10) tables, (1) closet, (8) bookshelves, (2) 4' x 4' map drawer cabinets. Contractor shall protect each item removed from damage. Contractor shall place all items removed back in the building.

- 2) Question: Who will be responsible for removing and reinstalling the audio-visual equipment in the balcony?

Answer: Contractor shall be responsible for the removal and reinstallation of the audio/visual (A/V). Contractor shall provide an A/V subcontractor to remove, store, and re-install all A/V equipment necessary to facilitate work per the contract. Provide climate controlled storage for the equipment. Contractor shall photograph, tag, record the location of, remove from the building, and store each piece of A/V equipment. Contractor shall provide an electronic copy of the A/V equipment condition pictures and locations to the government on CD. A/V equipment includes but is not limited to: (2) cameras, (1) projector, (1) soundboard with cabinet, (4) speakers with tri-pod stands, and (1) A/V cabinet. Contractor shall protect each item removed from damage. Contractor shall have certified A/V subcontractor place all items removed back in the building.

- 3) Question: Given the breadth of interpretation of the note concerning the re-pointing of masonry, can you please provide a square footage of repointing to be included in the bid?
